## **Surgical PharmaPak™ Contents:**

- Chlorhexidine Gluconate Wash 4%
- Mupirocin 2% Ointment
- DermacinRx® Skin Repair Complex (Dimethicone 5%)
- Silicone Tape

## **Prescribing Directions:**

- Step 1: Wash with Chlorhexidine liquid the night prior to, and the morning of the procedure as directed.
- Step 2: Apply Mupirocin Ointment to the wound site three times daily for 3-5 days or as directed.
- Step 3: One wound has healed, apply Skin Repair Complex up to 4 times daily or as directed. Apply Silicone tape at night before bed and remove in morning.

## **Description:**

Pre-operative bathing using Chlorhexidine Gluconate 4% contained in DermacinRx® Surgical ComboPak™ is FDA approved as a pre-operative wash and clinically proven to reduce the incidence of acquired infection due to Methylcillin-Resistant Staphylococcus Aureus (MRSA) and Vancomycin-Resistant Enterococcus (VRE)<sup>1</sup>

Maintenance of post-op wounds are an important factor to improve healing and reducing visible scars. DermacinRx Surgical Combopak contains mupirocin ointment as a topical antibiotic for incision sites and DermacinRx Skin Repair Complex containing a powerful skin protectant (Dimethicone 5%) with DermacinRx® Protein complex. This novel formula works on both the inner and outer layers of the skin. DermacinRx® Skin Repair complex contains ingredients clinically proven to improve cell turnover rate of wounds.<sup>2</sup>
